

Over 55,000 abortions at 15 weeks gestation or later each year in the U.S.

150 per day

Over 150 late-term (at or after 15 weeks) abortions per day.




That's almost seven elementary school classrooms of kids per day.

The most recent **<u>state-level data</u>** shows that **the majority of late-term abortions are performed for elective reasons.**

In <u>Florida</u> and <u>Utah</u>, **88 percent** of secondtrimester abortions are elective.

- 10 percent for fetal abnormality.
- 1 percent for non-lethal health issues.
- 1 percent total for the tragic cases of a life-threatening health issue, rape, and incest.



<u>National studies and estimates</u> are in line with the examples from Florida and Utah. Current data is pre-*Dobbs*.

Even the **pro-abortion Guttmacher Institute** <u>admits</u> that "data suggests that most women seeking later terminations are not doing so for reasons of fetal anomaly or life endangerment."
